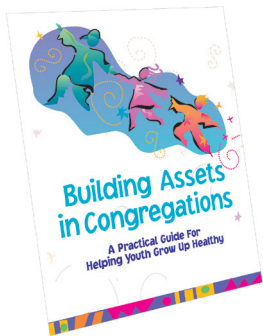
Key content:
