

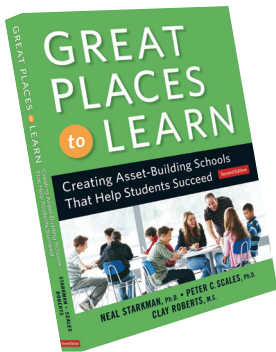
Deepening Asset Building in School Communities

This workshop for schools extends the content of *Building Developmental Assets in School Communities*.
