Key content:

- Assessing school climate and ways to impact change in four areas.
- Putting leadership skills into action.
- Creating a detailed action plan with follow-up expectations.

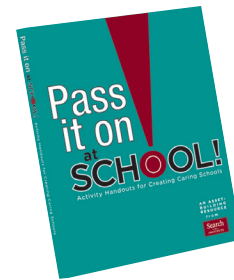
