I request that the following language be reported in the Labor-HHS and Education  
Appropriations Bill under the Funds for Improvement (FIE) Account.

Caring School Climate: All students should be provided with a school climate that is supportive  
and rich in developmental assets, strengths and supports. Students learn better and achieve more  
when they are in a school characterized by strong adult-student relationships, an environment  
that provides opportunities for all students to excel, and programs and practices that help young  
people grow up healthy, caring, and responsible

The Department of Education is encouraged to partner with Search Institute to provide resources,  
publications and trainings to state and local educational agencies on the positive relationships,  
opportunities, values, and skills that students need to succeed in school and avoid risky behavior.  
Resources should include a free information service, using print, electronic media, and the  
Internet, for schools, principals, school officers, parent-teacher associations, and community  
groups, relating to infusing developmental assets, supports and strengths into existing school  
curriculum, programs and services.
